

International dimension of Erasmus+ 2014-2020 in key figures



- ✓ ~270k planned short-term staff and student mobilities
- ✓ 250 excellent integrated Master courses funded
- ✓ 24 500 Erasmus Mundus scholarships awarded (2004-2020)
- ✓ Over 750 Capacity Building Higher Education projects
- ✓ Over 900 Capacity Building Youth projects
- ✓ **Over 1 600** Jean Monnet activities funded (more than 1/3 involving Partner

Funding of international dimension 2021-2027

- Stronger international dimension: Contribute to the geopolitical dimension of the European Education Area and support development cooperation objectives.
- Mixed funding:
 - Part of main budget (€26,2 billion of Heading 2 funding)
 - > + almost €2,2 billion from Heading 6:
 - ✓ IPA III (WB, ~€377 million EUR)
 - ✓ NDICI (rest of the world, €1,8 billion EUR).
- The exact split of the budget by action being negotiated.
- The nr and composition of regions to be clarified.






