The DHIP Project Overview

- Start date: 15 OCTOBER 2017
- Former end date: 14 OCTOBER 2020
- New end date (post COVID Emergency): 14 OCTOBER 2021

Overall Objective

To develop and integrate the international dimension within the structural and cultural components of Latin American Universities, through the design and implementation of Internationalization Enhancement Plans (IEPs)







• SO1 - To develop and/or improve effective HEI internationalization strategies consistent with the ECHE principles and priorities through the design and implementation of IEPs.









• SO2 - To increase and/or consolidate a network of contacts and regional alliances with peers and with other institutions or associations for mobility, academic exchanges including the use of Tuning tools to effect the shift to student centred learning, and experience with the Latin American Reference Credit - CLAR.







- SO3 To develop soft skills and transversal competencies and provide specialist training on strategic topics for the implementation of the IEP.
- SO4 Develop participation, communication and networking tools able to connect HEI internationalization policies with the needs/vocations of the local production systems.







• SO5 - Promote the dissemination of institutional strategies for internationalization based on good practices among the Latin American HEIs community and

Support the development of strategic alliances with other Latin American and European HEIs and the inclusion of communities of knowledge and of practice that can boost the viability of IEPs and that generate new initiatives and activities.







The DHIP Short Term Impact

- Institutionalization of international mobility strategies and policies through Internationalization Enhancement Plans
- Strengthening of soft skills and transversal competences
- Increase international mobility of students and academic staff







The DHIP Short Term Impact

- Increase the multicultural experiences of the students involved
- Raising awareness on the ECHE, Tuning and CLAR principles
- Strengthening of regional and international networks.







The DHIP Long Term Impact

- Increase of the international mobility rate
- Improvement of LA HEIs positioning in relation to international mobility
- Increase of the international attractiveness of LA HEIs
- Improvement of the training level of students and researchers
- Increase of knowledge and skills (linguistic, intercultural, but also soft) with respect to internationalization, through specific initiatives


